

Alternative study spaces across campus

The Map Room

Located in the Cohen Building, the Map Room is suitable for silent study; there are only a limited number of power outlets. It is a self-managed area and will remain open so long as students behave responsibly.

Computer Rooms

These are located across the campus with various sizes and capacities; they can be used for computer access if not in use for teaching.

24 Hour Centres

The Hull campus has two 24 hour PC centres, one located in the Larkin building, the other in the Foss Building.

Places to Eat

The campus has many places to eat and these can often provide a comfortable place to study provided you are willing to buy a cup of coffee or slice of cake.

Artcafe – open Monday to Friday, 9.30 am to 4.00 pm. Located in the Middleton Hall, serving Italian coffees and hot and cold snacks

Zucchini's – open Monday to Friday, from 9.00 am to 3.30 pm. Located in the Wilberforce Building, serving freshly made sandwiches, coffee and snacks.

The Cafe - Semester-time opening hours are Monday and Wednesday 8.30 am to 8.00 pm; Tuesday and Thursday, 8.30 am to 5.00 pm; and Friday 8.30 am to 4.00 pm. Located in the Derwent Building, on the western side of the campus, and serving drinks and snacks.

Bain Cafe - open Monday to Friday, from 8.30 am – 2.30 pm. Situated on the western side of the campus and serving tea, coffee, hot and cold sandwiches, jacket potatoes, crisps and confectionary

Places to Meet

In addition there is also the Retreat and the Haven, located on the first floor of University House (Student's Union Building); these are spaces open to all to eat and relax. They are 'bring your own food' areas and are often quiet early in the morning and in the evening, so they can be a great place to study and relax.
