

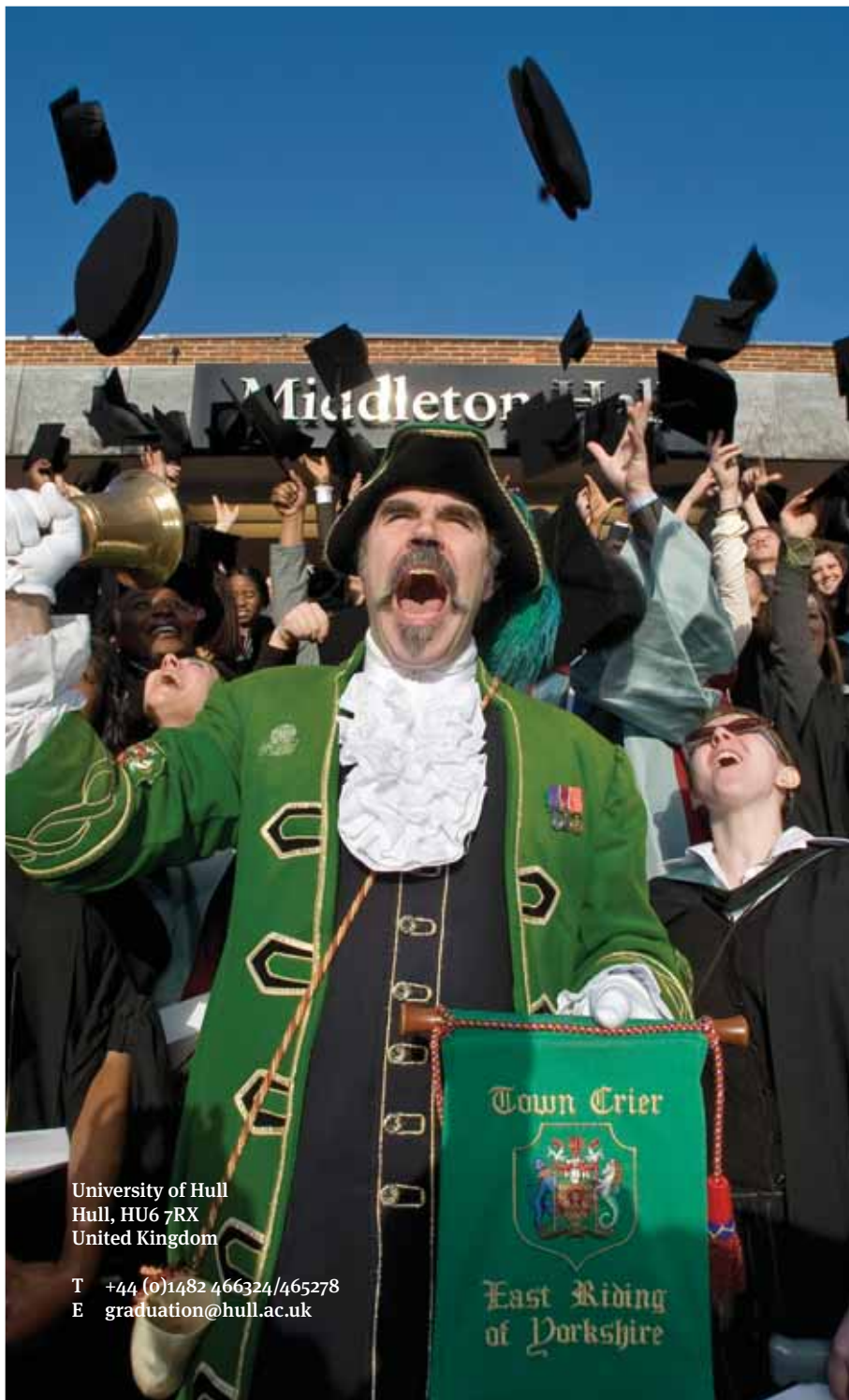

What do I need to wear?

To participate in the ceremony you are required to wear academic robes.

Academic robes for Bachelors and Masters degrees consist of a black gown with a hood lined with the University silk – turquoise blue taffeta.

Undergraduate diploma candidates attending the Faculty of Health and Social Care ceremony in July wear a black gown of the undergraduate pattern.

Caps are square mortar boards with a black silk tassel.

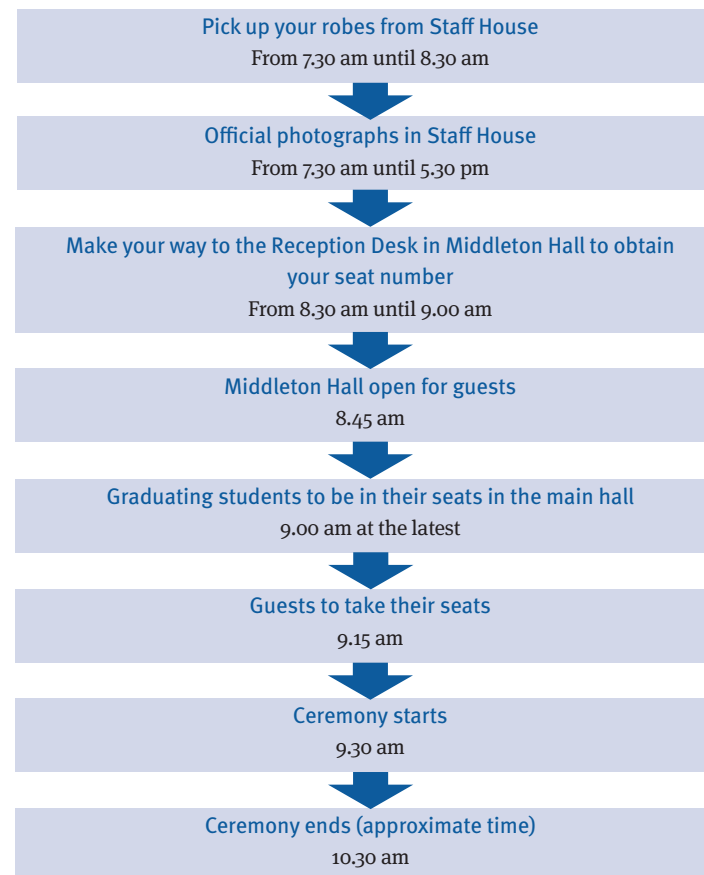

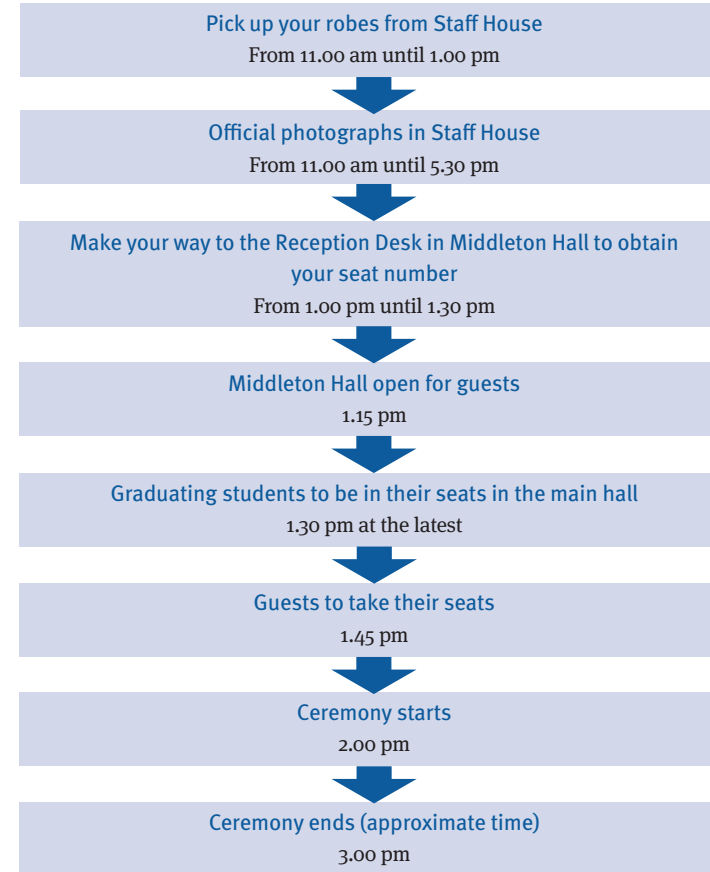

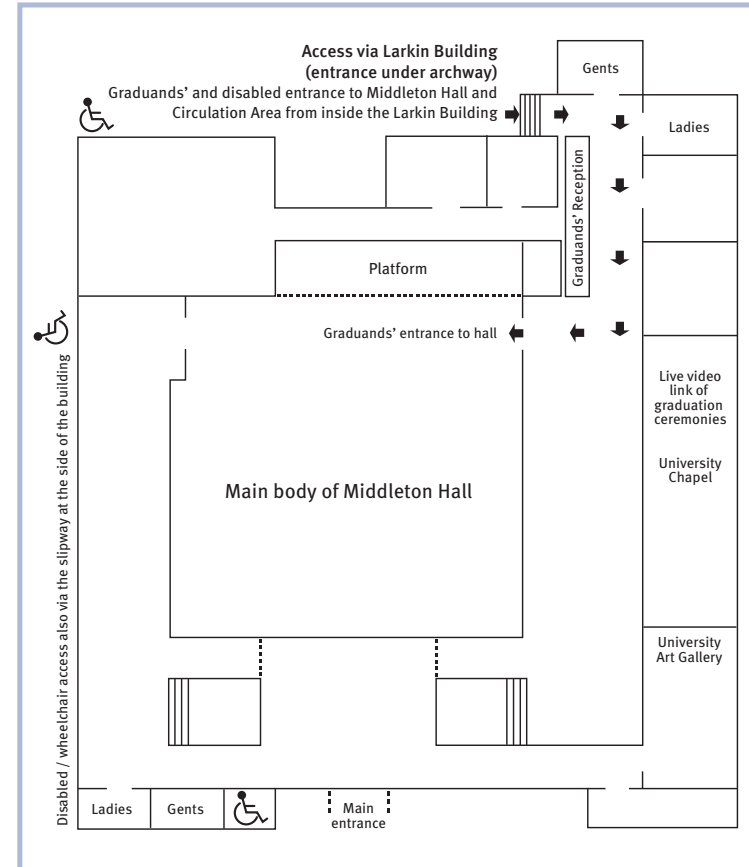

Frequently asked questions

Am I eligible to attend a degree ceremony?

This brochure is sent to all students who **may** be eligible to graduate in January 2012. You will only be allowed to graduate if your name appears on an official pass list and you have no outstanding debts to the University.

When and where is my graduation ceremony taking place?

All graduation ceremonies take place in the Middleton Hall on the Hull Campus. Ceremony dates and times for each faculty/school can be found on page 4 of this booklet.

I can't make the date of my graduation – can I swap to a different day?

If you cannot make the date of your graduation ceremony this winter, unfortunately you will not be able to attend on a different day as the ceremonies are specific to each faculty and department. You have two options: you can either graduate *in absentia* or defer to the summer ceremonies, which take place in July 2012 (at the City Hall for Hull Campus students, at the Spa Complex in Scarborough for Scarborough Campus students).

What if my plans change and I can't attend my degree ceremony?

Please contact Student Administrative Services (Graduation) immediately. You can either graduate *in absentia* (your certificate will be posted to you after the ceremony) or, if you are a degree student, defer your graduation to the summer ceremonies in July 2012. **If you choose to defer to a different ceremony, you will not receive your certificate until the date of this ceremony as the certificate includes your graduation date.**

My friend has not received a graduation information booklet. Can I let them have mine?

Please do not pass on this graduation information booklet to other people – there may be a good reason why they have not received one.

Is there anything I need to do in preparation for my graduation?

In preparation for your graduation you need to do the following.

- (1) Return your reply form to Student Administrative Services (Graduation), confirming your attendance at the ceremony for your department and faculty. The closing date for replies is **22 November 2011**. Postgraduates may have been given a later closing date, but this will be indicated on the reply form.
- (2) Hire or purchase your gown from Ede & Ravenscroft.
- (3) Book your celebration lunches. Refer to pages 17–20.

Please note: Your name can only be amended *before* the formal approval of your award. See page 15–16.

How many guests can I bring?

You will automatically be allocated two guest tickets. If you want to bring extra guests, you can request tickets on the reply form. Extra tickets may be allocated for the live video coverage of each graduation ceremony in the University Chapel and not for the Middleton Hall. Once all reply forms have been received, **extra guest tickets will be allocated as fairly as possible and sent out with the basic allocation**. However, it is not expected that many additional tickets will be available at any of the ceremonies. Please do not make travel or accommodation arrangements for extra guests until you have definitely been allocated tickets for them. See also page 14.

I am (or a member of my graduation party is) disabled. What should I do?

Please complete the appropriate section (5) on the reply form and/or contact Student Administrative Services (Graduation) as soon as possible. If any of your guests are disabled, **it is important to contact us before guest tickets are issued in case special seating arrangements are required**. Students with mobility disabilities may be seated on the platform.

When should I expect my tickets to arrive?

Tickets will be posted on **9 January 2012** to the UK address you provide on the reply form. If you live overseas and cannot provide a UK address, you will need to collect your tickets from Student Administrative Services (Graduation), or collect them from the Reception Desk in Middleton Hall on the day of your ceremony. Please note that guest tickets are non-transferable and cannot be given to friends. If you no longer require them, please return tickets to Student Administrative Services (Graduation) as soon as possible.

I am not sure whether I have any outstanding debts to the University. Should I check?

Yes – if you have any outstanding debt to the University after **2 December 2011**, you will not be permitted to graduate. If you have a debt and have already told us that you are attending, you will receive a letter from Student Financial Services informing you that you must clear your debt before you can graduate. Student Financial Services can be contacted on 01482 465674 or 01482 466362.

Important information

Dress code

The University of Hull operates a strict dress code at the graduation ceremonies. The appropriate academic dress (a gown, hood and cap) must be worn, and this can be hired (or purchased) from Ede & Ravenscroft. This is a very special day for the University as well as for all students and their families, and we ask that you dress smartly.

Men must wear a smart suit, shirt and tie with smart shoes.

Women must wear a smart suit, skirt or trousers with a shirt or blouse. Please ensure that your blouse or shirt has buttons down the front so that your hood can be properly secured.

International students may wear their national costume under their academic gown.



Please note that jeans, trainers or flip-flops should not be worn. Any student not complying with this dress code will not be permitted to graduate.

Robe hire

You need to order the correct robes in advance of the ceremony directly from Ede & Ravenscroft (01223 861854 / customerservices@edeandravenscroft.com). We strongly advise you to contact Ede & Ravenscroft straight away and certainly no later than **9 January 2012**. When collecting your academic robes on the day, you will need to produce your order number or receipt from Ede & Ravenscroft. If you are hiring your academic dress, you will need to retain the name label when you return the items after your ceremony. Students with long hair may find it useful to bring hairgrips and safety pins to secure the hat and the hood.

Robe collection

You need to collect your academic robes, hood and hat from Staff House during the times indicated on pages 5–8 of this booklet. You will need to return your robes to Staff House by 5.30 pm.

Cost of graduation

The University of Hull is one of the few remaining institutions that do not charge for graduation. You must, however, pay for your gown hire and this charge is payable directly to Ede & Ravenscroft, the robe hire company.

Photographs

The University's authorised graduation photographers are Tempest Photography. We advise you to be cautious of any approaches from unauthorised photographers.

Tempest Photography will be available in **Staff House** on the day of your ceremony. There are allotted times for photography for each separate ceremony – please refer to pages 5–8 of this booklet for further details.

Entry to the ceremony

Once robed, please make your way to Middleton Hall on campus and report to the Reception Desk. You must report to the Reception Desk to obtain your seat number for the ceremony. Once you have your seat number, you need to make your way to your seat in the main hall. **You must be in your allocated seat at least 30 minutes before the start time** as you will be given important instructions relating to the ceremony. **If you arrive late, you risk not being admitted to the ceremony and your graduation is likely to be delayed to another ceremony.**

Guests

Guests will only be admitted to any of the graduation ceremonies on production of a valid guest ticket for that ceremony.

Once the ceremony has started, guests are requested not to leave their seats. We also ask that guests do not take flash photographs during the ceremony.

Guest visa letters

If you would like to invite guests who require a visa to enter the country, the University can provide you with a letter of invitation that they can use to support their visa applications. The letter will formally invite you to the graduation ceremony. Each of your intended guests will need to submit a copy of this, plus a letter of invitation from yourself (i.e. a letter, written by you, inviting that person to accompany you to the ceremony) to the relevant authorities.

Please note that, as the University can only guarantee two guest tickets for the ceremony, we can supply no more than two copies of the letter.

Two versions of the letter are available. If your result has been formally approved, your letter will state that you have been 'officially invited' to the graduation ceremonies; if you are awaiting your result, you will be supplied with a letter stating that you are 'expected to attend' the ceremonies.

If you would like to make a request for a letter, please download the 'Request University Letter' form (DCform) by visiting www.hull.ac.uk/graduation, or email us at graduation@hull.ac.uk. It usually takes 3–5 working days for applications to be processed. Letters can be collected from Student Administrative Services (Graduation) or posted to the address given on the application form.

Guest tickets

You will be automatically issued two guest tickets, but you can request extra tickets on the reply form enclosed. Once all reply forms have been received, extra tickets will be allocated as fairly as possible and sent out with the basic allocation. However, it is not expected that many additional tickets will be available at any of the ceremonies, so please do not make travel or accommodation arrangements for any guests until you have definitely been allocated tickets for them.

Extra guest tickets may be allocated for the live video link of each graduation ceremony in the University Chapel and not for the Middleton Hall.

Tickets will be posted to the UK address that you provide on the graduation reply form. If you live overseas and cannot provide a UK address, you will need to collect your tickets from Student Administrative Services (Graduation), or collect them from the Reception Desk in the Middleton Hall, on the day of your ceremony. Please note that guest tickets are non-transferable and cannot be given to friends. **If you no longer require them, please return tickets to Student Administrative Services (Graduation) as soon as possible.**

Children

It is requested that children under the age of five are not brought to the ceremonies as these are lengthy formal events that are unsuitable for young children. Other children of 5 years and over should be supervised at all times and have their own ticket. The Family Information Service can provide details of creches and nurseries in the local area. Disabilities

Arrangements can be made for anyone attending the graduation ceremony, either as a graduate or as a guest, who may have special needs (e.g. because they use a wheelchair or have mobility difficulties). Students with mobility disabilities may be seated on the platform.

Please provide details in the appropriate section of the reply form, and/or contact Student Administrative Services (Graduation) in advance of the ceremony, to ensure that these are taken into consideration when tickets are allocated. Please note that it is important to let us know of any special needs **before** tickets are issued.

There is disabled access to the Middleton Hall. (See details in the Frequently Asked Questions section.)

Parking

Cars must not be parked on campus roads. Car-parking attendants will be on duty on the University campus to assist you, and signage will be displayed to direct you to a designated parking area (Salmon Grove).

Certificates and registered names

It is your responsibility to ensure that your name during your time at the University has been registered correctly on the Student Portal (University Academic Information System). The name recorded is exactly the name that will appear on your certificate and the departmental pass list. This is the University's official record of your graduation.

Therefore, it is important that your name was correctly recorded at the beginning of your last academic year as shown on your birth certificate, national ID card, passport, etc. **If you are an undergraduate or postgraduate, any change to your registered name cannot be made after the formal approval of your award.** Unfortunately, it is not possible to change or amend names after you graduate and the certificate has been issued.

If you list names on your graduation reply form which differ from those registered on the Student Portal (University Academic Information System), these will not be included on your certificate unless these changes were made through your department before the formal approval of your award. Please note that the formal approval date is not the graduation date.

If you are a student from a country where names are shown in a different order from the norm in the UK, Student Administrative Services (Graduation) can ensure that your names are printed on your certificate in the order that is conventional in your home country. So that requests can be processed in time,

you must indicate this on the reply form enclosed with this booklet or email graduation@hull.ac.uk stating the order of names you require. We need at least five weeks' notice to process this in time for your graduation. Please note that Student Administrative Services (Graduation) is only authorised to amend the order of names – we cannot add, delete or change the spelling of names already recorded on the Student Portal.

Dispatch and collection of certificates

If you are attending the ceremony you will be presented with your certificate on the day. For those not attending and graduating in *absentia* certificates will be sent out to the address provided on your reply form in the week beginning 6 February 2012. However, if you wish to collect your certificate in person or authorise someone to collect it on your behalf after the ceremony, you will need to complete a **certificate collection form** at least three weeks prior to the ceremony by emailing graduation@hull.ac.uk or downloading a form by visiting www.hull.ac.uk/graduation. Certificates may be collected from the customer service desk in University House following the ceremony.

Certified true copies of certificates

Please take care of your certificate as only one original is produced. If you lose your certificate or it is badly damaged and you need a certified copy, you can apply in writing via email (graduation@hull.ac.uk) or you can visit www.hull.ac.uk/graduation and download a copy of the Certified Copy Certificate Application Form. Copy certificates cost £30.00. Please complete payment details on the application form or write a cheque for the appropriate amount, payable to 'The University of Hull'. Please send applications and payments to Student Administrative Services (Graduation), University of Hull, Hull, HU6 7RX.

Authenticated photocopies of certificates

If you require an authenticated photocopy of your original certificate, you will also need to send a photocopy of your original certificate (if requested after graduation) with your application. You can apply in writing to Student Administrative Services (Graduation) via email (graduation@hull.ac.uk) or you can visit www.hull.ac.uk/graduation and download a copy of the Certified Copy Certificate Form. Authenticated photocopies cost £3.00. Please complete payment details on the application form or write a cheque for the appropriate amount, payable to 'the University of Hull'. Please send applications and payments to Student Administrative Services (Graduation), University of Hull, Hull, HU6 7RX.

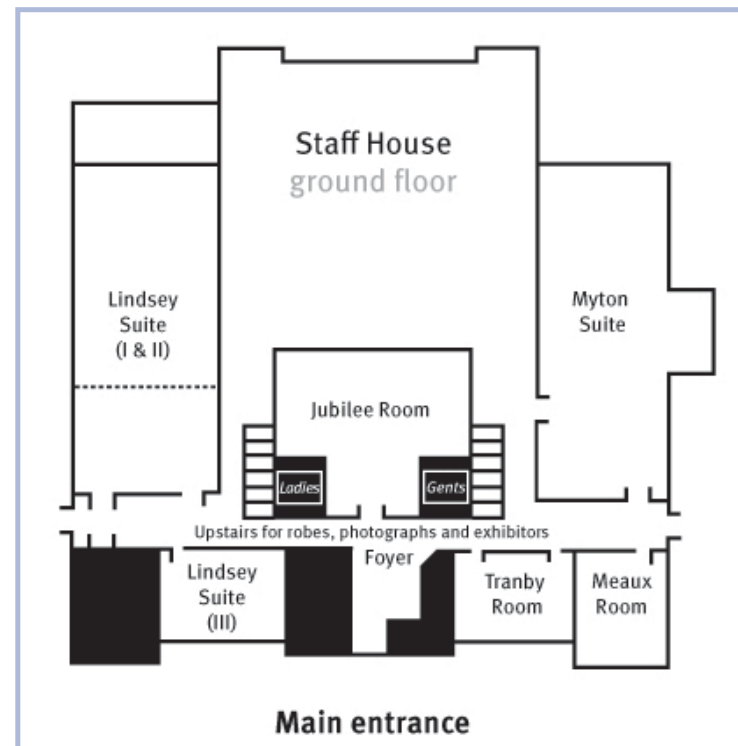

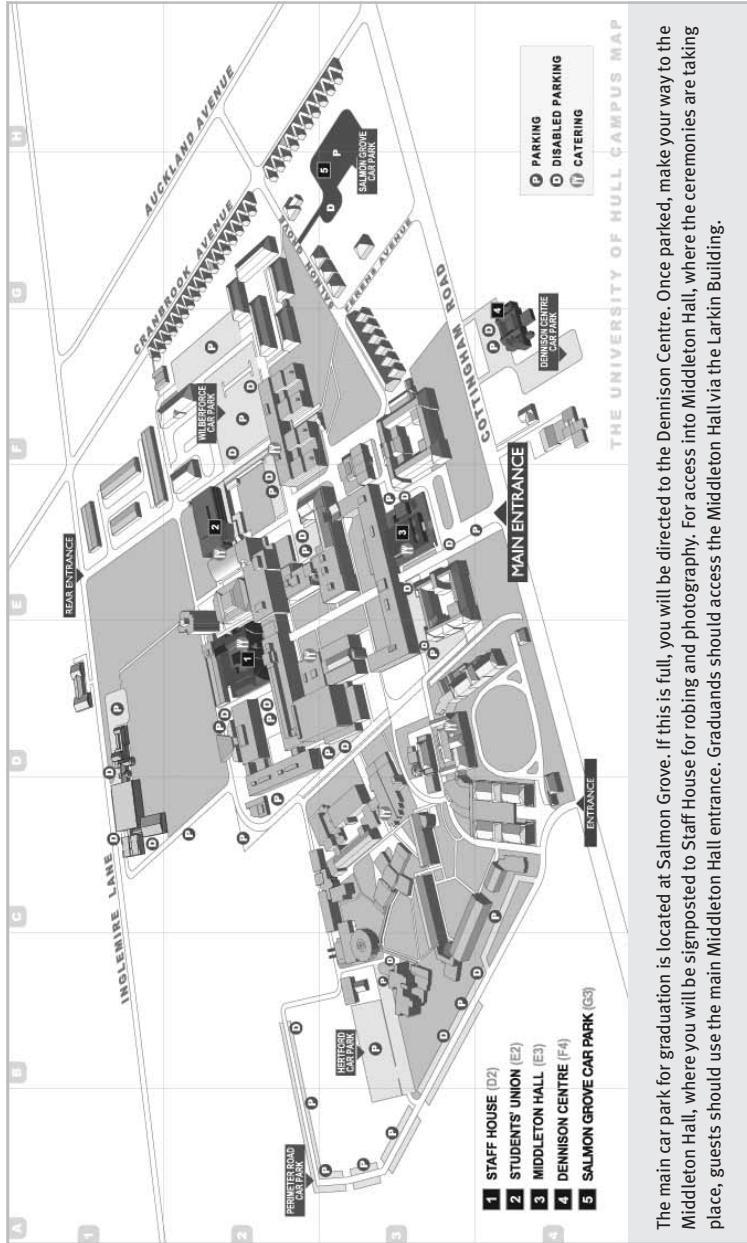

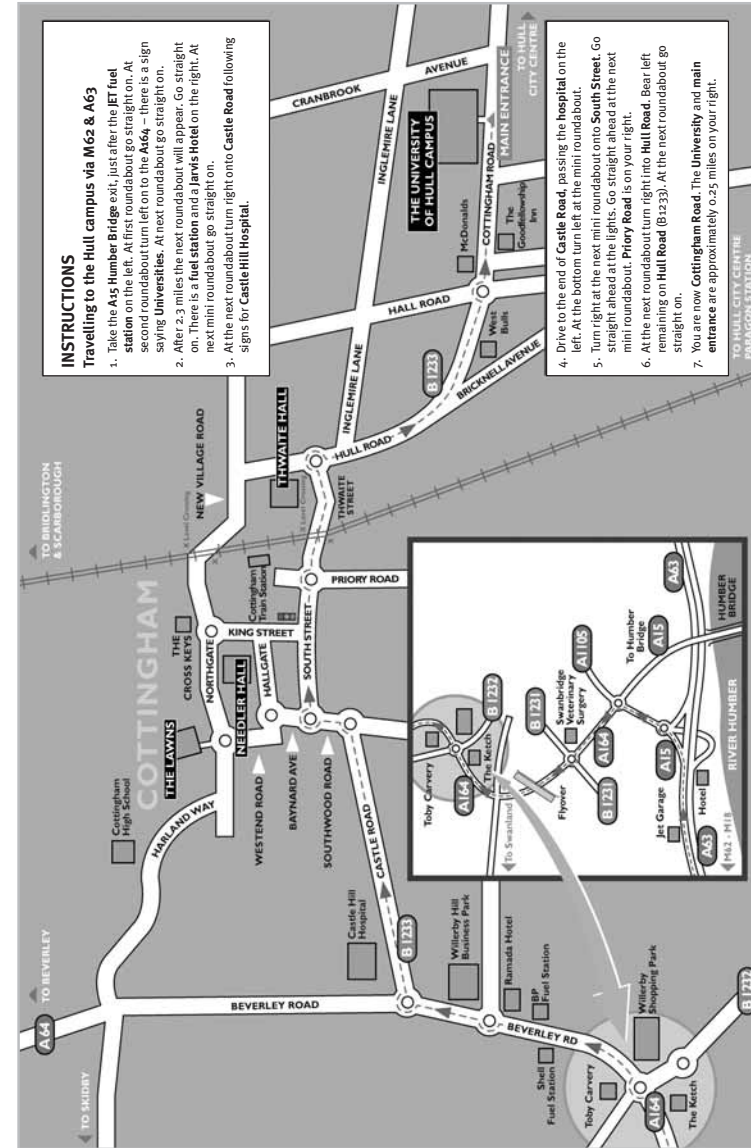

You will need to provide details of the date of your ceremony, the type of award you are receiving (Bachelor, Master, Doctor, etc) and some basic measurements to ensure that you have the correct size gown and hat.
